TRENHOLM TECH FOUNDATION NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS DECEMBER 31, 2006

NOTE 1 – NATURE OF ACTIVITIES AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Nature of Activities

The Trenholm Tech Foundation (The Foundation) is a private, nonprofit organization. The Foundation's purpose is to enhance the academic vision and priorities of H. Council Trenholm State Technical College in Montgomery, Alabama. The Foundation was established in 2002. The Foundation achieves its mission by fostering relationships with alumni and friends of Trenholm Tech by advocating charitable giving to the College.

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared on the accrual basis and accordingly reflect all significant receivables, payables, and other liabilities.

Basis of Presentation

Financial statement presentation follows the recommendation of the Financial Accounting Standards Board in its Statement of Financial Accounting Standards (SFAS) No. 117, Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations. Under SFAS 117, the Organization is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates

Property and Equipment

Acquisitions of property and equipment in excess of \$500 are capitalized. Property and equipment are carried at cost or, if donated, at the approximate fair value at the date of donation. Depreciation is computed on a straight-line basis over the useful lives of the assets.

NOTE 1 – NATURE OF ACTIVITIES AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Revenue Recognition

All contributions are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor. Amounts received that are designated for future periods or restricted by the donor for specific purposes are reported as temporarily restricted or permanently restricted support that increases those net assets classes. When a restriction expires (that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished), temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

Income Taxes

The Foundation is exempt from Federal Income Taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is not a private foundation.

Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents consist of short-term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible into cash within (90) days of purchase.

Board of Directors Trenholm Tech Foundation Montgomery, Alabama

In planning and performing our audit of the financial statements of the Trenholm Tech Foundation as of and for the year ended December 31, 2006, in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, we considered the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting (internal control) as a basis for designing our audit procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control.

Our consideration of internal control was for the limited purpose described in the preceding paragraph and would not necessarily identify all deficiencies in internal control that might be significant deficiencies or material weaknesses. However, as discussed below, we identified certain deficiencies in internal control that we consider to be significant deficiencies and other deficiencies that we consider to be material weaknesses.

A control deficiency exists when the design or operation of a control does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent or detect misstatements on a timely basis. A significant deficiency is a control deficiency or combination of control deficiencies that adversely affects the entity's ability to initiate, authorize, record, process or report financial data reliably in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles such that there is more than a remote likelihood that a misstatement of the entity's financial statements that is more than inconsequential will not be prevented or detected by the entity's internal control. We consider the following deficiency to be a significant deficiency in internal control.

The nature of the accounting records maintained during the year 2006 adversely affected the Foundation's ability to record, properly classify, and report financial data reliably. During our audit, we noted that accounting records were maintained using Excel software but did not include provisions for properly categorizing, summarizing, and reporting financial transactions. Additionally, the accounting records for 2006 did not capture transactions relating to interest income. In 2007 the Foundation did take steps to mitigate this significant deficiency by investing in accounting software. However, the creation of appropriate account categories and evidence of the ability to effectively utilize the capabilities inherent in the accounting software, although currently being improved, was not clearly evident during our engagement. We recommend that the Foundation obtain the services of an individual or company to provide training in the use of the software including the establishment of an appropriate chart of accounts to be used to capture, record, classify, and report accounting transactions in accordance with accounting

principles generally accepted in the United States. This effort will assist the Foundation in attaining reasonable assurance that reporting will properly reflect financial results.

A material weakness is a significant deficiency, or combination of significant deficiencies, that results in more than a remote likelihood that a material misstatement of the financial statements will not be prevented or detected by the Foundation's internal control. We believe that the following deficiency constitutes a material weakness.

During our audit, we identified a material misstatement in the financial statements related to five checks that were written but not recorded in the accounting records. These expenditures were for properly authorized amounts but were not recorded in accounting records provided to us. The Foundation's investment in accounting software with the capability to perform bank account reconciliations utilizing the software should mitigate this material weakness.
